What Does Troop 261 Offer?

Diversity: Our 34 Scouts (4 patrols) and 13 Adult Leaders come from Columbus, Dublin, Grandview, Hilliard, Marble Cliff, and Upper Arlington.

Camping: We camp under the Patrol Method EVERY MONTH (ask for our calendar)

Leadership Training: We commit to training at the Troop Level (Troop JLT), District Level (JLOW- Junior Leader Orientation Workshop), Council Level (Brownsea JLT), and National Junior Leader Training (Philmont)

Leadership Instruction: 6 Scouts and 1 Adult are Council Level JLT Instructors (25% of Staff)

Community Service: We provide over 100 hours every year to the surrounding communities

Summer Camp: We participate in yearly BSA Summer Camps (ask for our calendar)

High Adventure Trek: An annual weeklong excursion at sites around the country (see Schedule)

Planned Calendar: Year long activity calendar is planned in August covering weekly meetings and monthly campouts. Planning skills learned through JLT courses are employed

History: In 2003, our Troop celebrated its 50th year of Duty to God and Country, Duty to Others, and Duty to Self. We have awarded the Eagle Scout rank to 151 young men.

Troop Policy: We provide a thorough **Troop Policy and Procedure** handbook to each Scout covering all aspects of his role and obligation to the troop.

Pack Presentation: We give a Boy Lead presentation to your Pack according to your schedule (call).

Cross Over Ceremony: We provide a complete Arrow Of Light and Crossover Ceremony for your Pack (call, no obligation!).
